PARKING

Plan Ahead – Arrive Early

NO PARKING AT THE START LINE BUT TWO WAYS TO GET THERE

SHUTTLE SERVICE

From Davis Ranch Parking Lot - Cascade HWY 55 one mile north, right on Warm Lake Rd
and 1 mile to parking lot

Due to a region wide bus driver shortage, we were unable to secure schools buses but
will be running 15 - 20 passenger shuttles, every 15 minutes. Please arrive early and
think about Car Pooling.

Shuttles begin at 9:30 am and operate Jan 30, 31 and Feb 1

Or

CAR POOL

To help reduce lines waiting for shuttle space & to help reduce exposure if not comfortable in confined spaces.

Drop passengers at the start line, then driver turns around and proceeds to the Davis Ranch Lot to catch the shuttle back to the start line.

This will be an unforgettable experience as you see teams arrive and depart checkpoints and observe mushers caring for their teams as they rest.
