PARKING

NO PARKING AT THE START LINE!

Like previous years, there is no event parking at the Lake Cascade checkpoint (i.e., the race starting line at the boat ramp).

PLAN AHEAD AND ARRIVE EARLY.

SHUTTLE SERVICE:

January 29 ● 8am-3pm, running every 15-20 minutes - Pick up at Hotel Nobo

Spectator parking is available at **Hotel NoBo** (500 N. Main St., Cascade, ID) and at the **Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints** (560 ID-55, Cascade, ID). Shuttles are able to hold 15 - 20 passengers.

UNLIKE PREVIOUS YEARS, NO PARKING IS AVAILABLE AT DAVIS RANCH NORTH OF CASCADE.

WHEN TO VISIT CHECKPOINTS

Trail conditions impact team travel times and time in the checkpoints is dependent on individual team strategy. The schedules below are approximate. The race trackers are the best indicator of when the teams will be in the checkpoints. Most teams will rest for some period of time in the checkpoints however certain checkpoints require a minimum amount of rest: 300-mile race requires 6 hours at Van Wyck and 3 hours at Platt | 100-mile race requires 3 hours at Little Ski Hill and 1-3 hours at Platt.

Walk 100 yards north to Platt Checkpoint.

WYF

The WYE checkpoint is campground at the north end of the Weiser River Trail.

Driving directions: From New Meadows, ID go south on Hwy 95 approximately six miles and turn left at Tamarack View Dr. and WYE Campground sign (1/8 mile south of MM 155). follow the road east 1/2 mile to the checkpoint.

THIRD FORK
